- Some courses in this major may also be used toward Foundation of Knowledge (general education) requirements.
- The Admission Semester is a "block" of classes. They must be taken together in the same semester. You may take other classes with this block if appropriate.
- All required courses must be completed with minimum grades and GPAs met before entering the Clinical Experience, and no other classes may be taken with it.
- Elective credit hours be necessary in order to earn the minimum of 120 credit hours required for graduation.
- Details on this checklist are subject to change including course rotation and availability, pre-requisites, and/or course credit hours. Maintain contact with your assigned advisor to make sure you remain informed of any such changes.
